- I. Call to Order
 - Dr. Temple called the meeting to order at 4:10 p.m.
- II. Invocation
 - Dr. Temple gave the invocation.
- III. Pledge of Allegiance
 - Mr. Bryant led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States.
- IV. Approval of Agenda
 - Mr. Bryant made a motion to adopt the agenda, Ms. Tobin seconded it, and the motion carried unanimously.
- V. Public Forum
 - No comments made.
- VI. Friends' Reports
 - A representative from the Friends of the West Florida Public Library read their report.

• The Friends of the Southwest Branch emailed their report to all Board members.

VII. Approval of the Minutes for June 20, 2016

 One change to the header date was recommended for the minutes. A motion to approve the minutes as amended was made by Mr. Bryant, seconded by Ms. Tobin, and passed unanimously.

VIII. Chairman's Report

- Dr. Temple spoke of the new Board of Governance member, Sally Fox, and asked Ms. Tobin to tell the board more about her.
- Mr. Bryant presented Chapter X, History of Library Funding, which he wrote for the Board of Governance manual. The Board made several suggestions for changes that were incorporated into the document. The document was saved as edited and will be forwarded to Ms. Tobin for compilation in the new manual.

IX. Director's Report

- Mr. Humble spoke to the Board about the fire truck rides used as a reward for six of the top readers from the Summer Reading Program. He also briefed the Board on the final statistics for the Summer Reading Program.
- Mr. Humble then went over the statistics for the previous month.
- Mr. Humble updated the Board of his currently submitted grant applications and a staff
 member who was awarded a grant to attend the Young Adult Library Services
 Association Conference in Pittsburgh, PA. Mr. Humble also asked for permission from
 the Board to allow him to pursue a non-matching grant up to \$250,000 that would allow
 WFPL to market and fund a Makerspace for the library. Mr. Bryant proposed a motion to
 allow it, Ms. Tobin seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
- Mr. Humble presented information regarding the current procedure for collecting delinquent fines and fees and the Board. Recommended fines and fees schedule will be submitted for Board of County Commissioner approval. Mr. Humble will develop ideas to make this change, to include how a collection service might be utilized for delinquent accounts.

X. Unfinished Business

- Mr. Humble updated the Board concerning the memorials for Francis Yeo and Rodney Kendig memorials. The Board opted to place it in unfinished business.
- Mr. Humble requested the Board allow Dr. Temple to sign the amended state aid for libraries agreement to allow the receipt of additional proposed monies. The motion was

made by Mr. Bryant to allow Dr. Temple or her designee to sign an amended state aid agreement. Dr. Guttmann seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

XI. New Business

• Dr. Temple again welcomed the new Board member, Sally Fox, who was not able to attend.

XII. Open Board Discussion

 Mr. Bryant spoke about the effort underway to make the school district have all texts in digital form and assigning all students a Chromebook. He wanted to see how the library could help with this effort and he suggested extended hours for Wi-Fi at the library branches for families that cannot afford internet access at home.
