**August 5<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 - 5:00 PM**

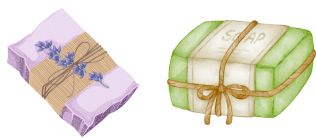
Enjoy this entry level class for making your own soaps at home! All materials will be provided as supplies last, and patrons may pick up their soap the next day. Recommended ages 12+.
