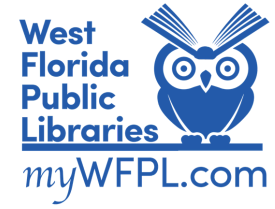

Free Summer Lunch Program for Youth

Molino Dates: May 26 through Aug. 7

West Florida Public Libraries will be serving free lunch for youth 18 years of age and younger\* at most library locations Monday through Friday from noon to 1 p.m. \*Disabled individuals 19 years of age and older who participate in a public or private non-profit program during the school year are also eligible to receive meals.
